DECIDING ON THE TYPE OF MUSIC

As you're planning your wedding, you should consider the things that both you and your fiance like – and your tastes in music are no exception. If you play music at your wedding reception that both you and your fiance agree on, the big day will be even more perfect for both of you. Here are some tips to help you and your fiance get on the same page when it comes to choosing your wedding reception music.

MAKE A LIST

To make sure neither of your wedding reception music wishes are ignored, you should each make a list of what you'd like to hear played during your reception. On your list, include songs that you want to hear on the big day and songs that you definitely want to be kept off the playlist. Once your lists are completed, go over them together. If there's a song you want played but your partner doesn't, come to a compromise. So, if your fiance dislikes one of your songs, and you dislike one of theirs, either agree to play both songs or to cut both from your wedding reception playlist.

TALK ABOUT BANDS VS DJS

You and your fiance might have different opinions on whether you should have a live wedding band, or a DJ play at your wedding reception. Make sure you talk about this early so that you're able to plan ahead. If your fiance doesn't agree with the one you want, there are a few things you can do. You might hire a band to play, then hire a DJ between band sets and have the DJ finish off the reception or perform at an afterglow. If you or your fiance have strong feelings about not wanting one or the other, try to be open minded when exploring your options. You can scope out bands and DJs together so that you both have a better idea

of what to expect. Seeing them perform might change or open your mind about having one of them at your reception.

PLAN THE MUSIC TOGETHER

One of the easiest ways to make sure both you and your fiance are happy with your wedding reception music is to plan it together. Ultimately, this is a day for both of you. It's not about any one person. If you have trouble planning your music together, look at it as your first opportunity to compromise! Marriage is all about compromising, so working together to find a music solution you'll both be happy with will be a great practice exercise.

THE LIVE BAND VS. DJ DEBATE

When you choose a live band, it often dramatically enhances the ambiance of your reception. There's just something about having live music at a wedding that gives it a timeless, romantic feeling. That doesn't mean that the band should only be skilled in one type of genre. The more variety the band can provide, the more your guests



will enjoy them. A good bandleader will play to the crowd at your reception. This is the biggest pro for choosing a band because the band can interact with guests, pay attention to the "feel" of the room, and select the best music for each spontaneous moment of the night.

Usually at weddings, you have multiple generations in a room. That means that there will likely be certain genres and decade music that some of your guests will expect, and others will be a little thrown off by. You can make all of your guests happy and get them out of their chairs by adding some variety to the genres you select so that there will be something for everyone.

...THAT FIT WITH THE PACE AND TIMELINE OF YOUR RECEPTION.

At wedding receptions, timing is everything. If your DJ plays slow music right at the highest energy point of the evening, it could ruin the mood. Likewise, if you play all upbeat dance songs, the crowd could become tired. Generally, you want to start with slow music during dinner and eventually build up to the upbeat songs when the party really gets going. Much of the timing of your music will be determined by your DJ or live wedding band, so make sure you choose one with tons of experience playing at wedding receptions.

The music that's played at your wedding reception could really make or break your special day. You want all of your guests to have the time of their lives, so please take all their personal preferences into account.
